**DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES**

About the Paul Bunyan State Forest of Minnesota: 105,000 acres, covering 164 sq. miles, making up part of Minnesota's north woods. Created in 1935, it started small in the early 1900s primarily for the millions of board feet of timber. The logging days lasted 20 years, with its peak creating 8-10 major logging camps and 4-5,000 men on the payroll. The central hub of all the lumber processing was on Eleventh Crow-Wing Lake and the City of Akeley.

**Motor vehicle usage in Minnesota State Forests are classified:**  
Paul Bunyan State Forest is classified as "Limited" for motor vehicle usage, meaning:  
• Highway licensed vehicles MAY OPERATE on signed forest roads.  
• Off-highway vehicles, [OHV's] defined as ATV's, [ATV's or UTV's] off highway motorcycles [OHM's], and off-road Vehicles [ORV's] MAY OPERATE on signed roads and on trails that are designated and signed for their specific use. No off-trail travel is allowed, except noted in hunting regulations.  
• Reminders of such are posted at many of the forest entrances. Please enjoy! ...be tolerant and be respectful to all.

**DEFINITIONS:**  
The Term, Off-Highway Vehicle (OHV), includes All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV's & UTV's), Off-Highway Motorcycles (OHM's) and Off-Road Vehicles (ORV's).

Some local Highlights of that information:  
Class 1 ATV: has a total width of 50 inches or less from outside of tire rims.  
Class 2 ATV: has total width of greater than 50 inches but not more than 65 inches from outside of tire rims.

All the Paul Bunyan State Forest Trails are rated for both Class 1 & Class 2 Registration:

OHVs must be registered to operate in Minnesota. (There are exemptions: SEE OHV regulations)  
Non-Resident OHV Trail Passes are required for ATV, OHM and ORV's.  
• A trail pass is required for non-residents operating an ATV or OHM, or OHV that is not registered in MN, on State or Grant-Aid trails.  
• Non-Resident ATV Trail Passes can be purchased for \$31.00 at these local ELS agents:

OHV trails in Minnesota are open from May 1st - October 31st annually, unless posted otherwise.

**GENERAL OPERATIONS OF ATVs That are commonly MISSED!**  
[Check full rules at [MNDNR.gov/ohv](http://MNDNR.gov/ohv) ]

- YOUTH: Anyone under the age of 16 must have permission from their parent or guardian to operate an ATV.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must wear a DOT approved helmet while operating or a passenger when riding on public lands, trails, frozen waters and when crossing road right-of-way.
- As an operator 18 years or age or older, you may carry one passenger on a Class 1 ATV. For a Class 2 ATV you may carry a passenger, or up to the number of passengers for which the ATV was designed.
- As an operator 12-17 years of age, you may carry one passenger on a Class 1 ATV only if the passenger is your parent or legal guardian.
- If your ATV is equipped with a headlight and taillight, they must be ON at all times.
- Equipment: Brakes and throttles must be in complete operating condition as designed by mfg. Mufflers must have a federally approved spark arrestor. MAY NOT exceed 99 decibels at a distance of 20 inches, MAY NOT be altered to increase motor noise.

The Timberland Dirt Devils is an ATV/UTV power sports club from the Akeley, MN area that was established in 2006. We are a not-for-profit organization whose Mission is to support the sport of trail riding. This is accomplished with our volunteer equity and funds, Youth Education Safety Program, user friendly trail rides, fund raising events, GIA-ATV trail maintenance, Trail Ambassadors, public education elements, special events, community service and other endeavors for the sport. Presently, we maintain 42 miles of ATV useable trails on the east side of Hwy 64 in the Paul Bunyan State Forest. This is 26 square miles covering 16,700 acres.

**MN-DNR VOL. TRAIL AMBASSADORS PROGRAM:**  
The TDD are proud to support the Trail Ambassadors Program. Annually we have supported 3-4 club members in their volunteer participation in this statewide OHV program. The program exists to promote safe, environmentally responsible operation of OHVs through informational & educational contacts and monitoring efforts.  
**YOUTH ATV SAFETY EDUCATION:**  
The TDD conducts an annual youth ATV educational day every June for interested area youth. We support members to become educators and encourage active practice once certified by the DNR Enforcement Division.  
We average 25-30 students, whom we assist with all course fees and provide a "Helmet and goggle set" for each student that successfully completes one of our classes.

**ATV/UTV TRAIL DEVELOPMENT & MAINTENANCE:**  
The TDD have 42 miles of ATV Trails to monitor and maintain on the east-side of Hwy 64 in the Paul Bunyan State Forest and Hubbard County.  
The efforts to keep our trails intact are endless, from good assessments planning, appropriate funding requests, environmental issues monitoring, appropriate trail footprints, to weekly safety and maintenance checks, good trail maintenance plans and user-friendly signage.
